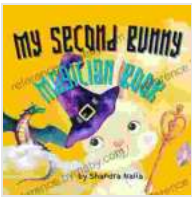

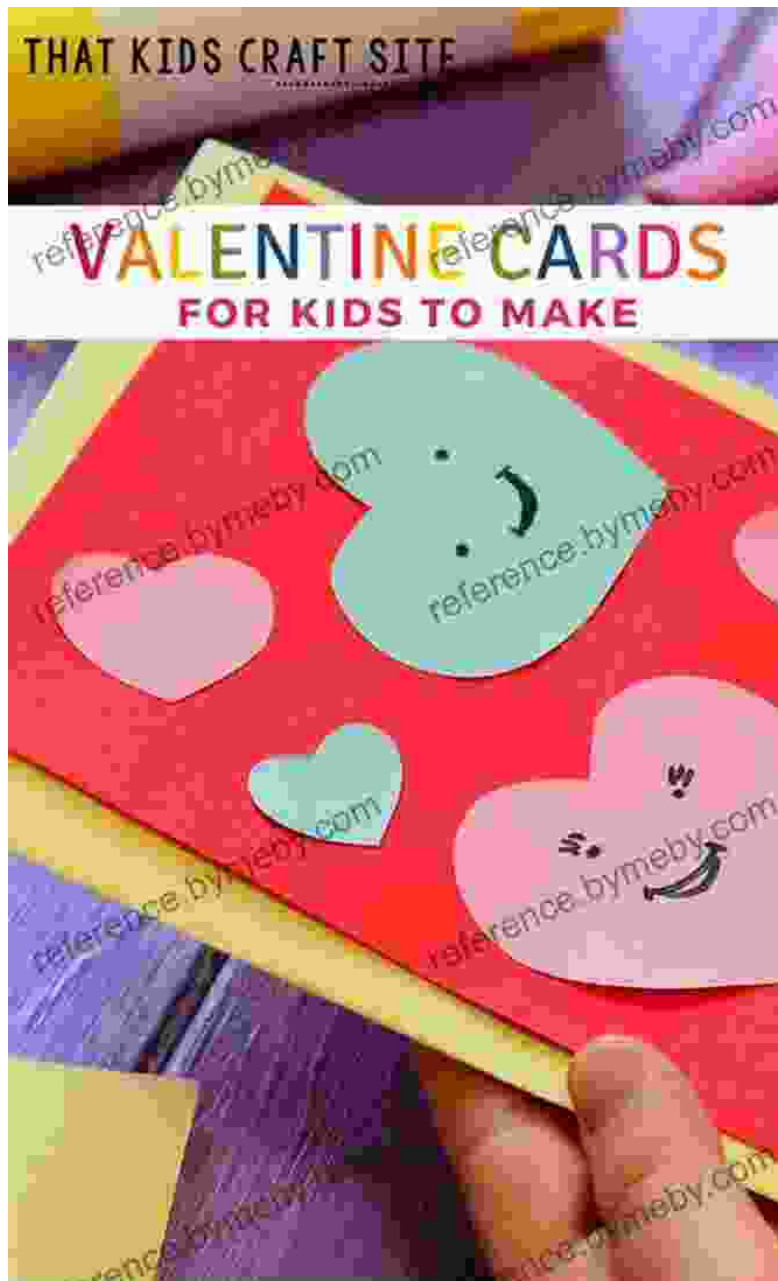
January

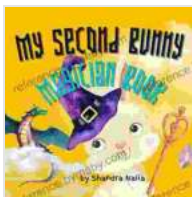


December

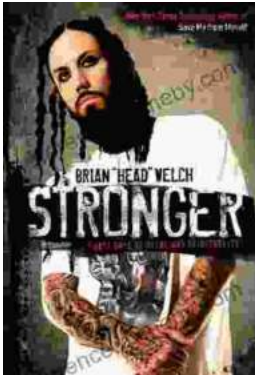

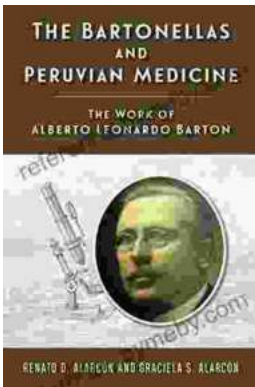
