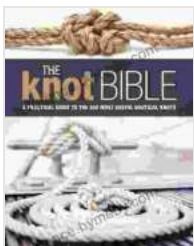

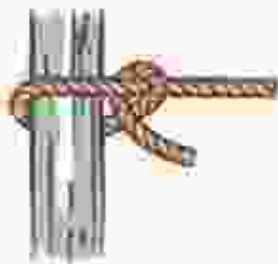

KNOTS THAT CONNECT THE LINE TO A SUPPORT

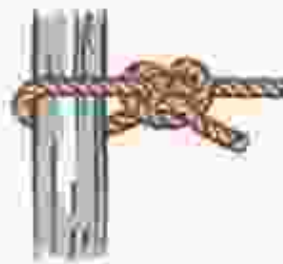
HALF HITCH

GLOVE HITCH

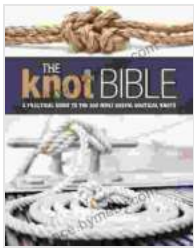

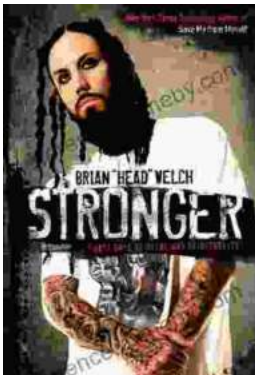

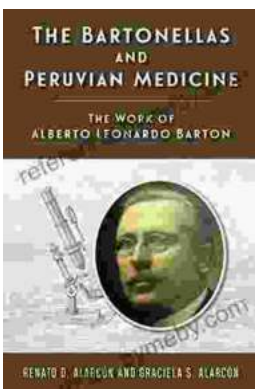
